


Holy Pittsburgh!

Tuesday, March 24th 2026

Have you ever hoped to get an inside look at some of the beautiful churches in Pittsburgh? This tour, perfectly placed during the season of Lent, will be perfect to make that happen! We will depart from our North Huntingdon campus (insert address) at 8 am on Tuesday, March 24th, on a comfortable motorcoach (with a bathroom on board in case of an emergency!) Our first stop will be at the Heinz Chapel in Oakland, PA where a docent will provide us with a tour. From there we will make our way to one of Pittsburgh's largest cathedrals, East Liberty Presbyterian Church, also known as the Cathedral of Hope. Built in part by gifts from the Mellon Family, this is a spectacular site to see.



Our next stop will be lunch, in church, of course! We will visit the Church Brew Works in Lawrenceville for a lunch buffet that will include Fresh Crudité, mixed green salad and bread, pasta pomodoro, chicken medallions, rice pilaf and sauteed vegetables, dessert, coffee or iced tea. Other beverages, including the house brewed beer, will be available to purchase by the guests.

After lunch we will head towards the north side of Pittsburgh to visit Calvary Methodist Church and their incredible Tiffany windows. Our last stop of the day will be at St. Anthony's Chapel to enjoy hearing about and seeing some of the relics on collection there. From then it's home to Redstone, where we anticipate arriving by 5 pm.

Cost for this full day of exploration is \$130 per person and includes motorcoach, driver gratuity, lunch, and a donation to each church that we will be visiting. Guests should be able to navigate getting on and off the bus with relative independence, but rollators and collapsible wheelchairs that can be stored under the bus are welcome.
